Job Description:

As a Full-Time street maintenance worker, you will be responsible for assisting in the maintenance and repair of city streets and related infrastructure. Work is primarily outdoors and may include but not limited to:

- Cleaning, maintenance and repair of City streets, sidewalks, storm drains and rights-of-way including sweeping, resurfacing, pavement patching, crack sealing, brush hogging, and removing vegetation.
- Installing, repairing, and replacing various street and regulatory signs, posts, and barricades.
- Operating hand and power tools such as pumps, compactors, saws, etc.
- Operating various public works equipment, such as dump truck, loader, sandblaster, jack hammer, chain saw, crack sealer, lance torch, etc.
- Using and operating flagging equipment to control traffic in vicinity of work crews.
- Performing general clean-up and minor maintenance to public works facilities.
- May provide general clean-up for vehicle crashes and removal of dead animals on city streets/rights-of-way.
- Clean and organize tools and toolboxes.
