The City Council of Little Flock, Arkansas met in regular session on Monday September 19, 2022, at 6:00 PM in the Little Flock City Hall

1. Meeting called to Order:

Mayor Jeff Van Sickler called the meeting to order at 6:00 PM.

2. Invocation & Pledge of Allegiance:

Council Member Rob Phillips gave the invocation, and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited.
