

## Thursday March 14, 2024

**Location and Time:** Little Flock City Hall at 6:00 pm

The City Council of Little Flock, Arkansas met in Special Session on Thursday, March 14, 2024 at 6:00 PM in the Little Flock City Hall. The City Council meeting for Monday March 18, 2024 has been cancelled with no agenda items to approve.

### **1. Meeting called to Order:**

Mayor Jeff Van Sickler called the meeting to order at 6:00 PM.

### **2. Invocation & Pledge of Allegiance:**

Alderman Rob Phillips gave the invocation, and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

### **3. Roll Call:**

Council Members present were Debb Formanek, Donny Barton, Robert Phillips, Wes Waddell, Sherry Moncrief, and Chris Cantwell.

Others in attendance: Recorder/Treasurer Richard Crow, Street Superintendent Wes Usery, and Police Chief Shawn Hollis

### **4. Public Comments:**

Mayor Van Sickler did not open the meeting for public comments as there were no attendees.

### **5. Action on Minutes:**

Mayor Van Sickler asked if there were any changes or corrections to the February 20th, 2024 minutes. There were none. Motion was made by Alderman Debb Formanek to approve the minutes. Second was made by Alderman Rob Phillips. **Motion passed unanimously.**

### **6. Treasurers Report:**

February 29, 2024 Treasurer's Report was provided.

General Fund Balance: \$3,222,833.20

Street Fund Balance: \$846,253.18

Alderman Rob Phillips made a motion to approve the Treasurers Report. A second was made by Alderman Debb Formanek. **Vote: Motion passed unanimously.**

### **7. Unfinished Business:**

- There was none

### **8. New Business:**

Bills over \$10,000:

Mayor requested approval to purchase three new police vehicles at a cost of \$44,300 each. Budgeted amount for each vehicle is \$45,000. A check in the amount of \$132,900 will be provided to the seller in North Carolina.

- A motion was made by Alderman Chris Cantwell to approve the payment. A second motion was made by Alderman Wes Waddell. **Vote: Motion passed unanimously.** (The total cost including travel expenses to obtain the vehicles is approximately \$134,523.14 which is under budget).
- A motion was made by Alderman Rob Phillips to allow for the three old vehicles to be placed on competitive bid for sale. A second motion was made by Alderman Chris Cantwell. **Vote: Motion passed unanimously.**
- Chief Hollis asked if Council would also approve spending approximately \$15,000 per vehicle, \$45,000 total, in "outfitting" them with equipment, decals, etc. The item was added to the agenda, and a motion was made by Alderman Rob Phillips to approve. A second was made by Alderman Debb Formanek. **Vote: Motion passed unanimously.**

### **9. Announcements:**

- Mayor announced that the park will be closed March 21-22, 2024 for installation of the new mulch.
- Mayor also announced that the Easter Egg Hunt is scheduled for March 30, 2024.
- There were questions and discussions on the new building process for the City Hall and Street Building. More to come in the next work session.


**10. Adjournment:**
