The City Council of Little Flock, Arkansas met in regular session on Monday April 21, 2025 at 6:00 PM in the Sunshine School.

1. Meeting called to Order:

Mayor Jeff Van Sickler called the meeting to order at 6:00 PM.

2. Invocation & Pledge of Allegiance:

Mayor Van Sickler gave the invocation. The pledge of Allegiance was recited.

3. Roll Call:

Council Members present were Debb Formanek, Chris Cantwell, and Natalie Tibbs, Sherry Moncrief, and Robert Phillips.

Others in attendance: Recorder/Treasurer Richard Crow, Police Chief Joe Powell, Street Superintendent Wes Usrey, Deputy Fire Marshall Riley Heasley, P&Z Commissioner Becky Featherston.

4. Public Comments:

Mayor Van Sickler opened the meeting for public comments.

- Debb Formanek received a call from a resident concerning erosion and debris from water runoff at the corner of
 Wildflower & Hwy 94. Mayor Van Sickler had a conversation with the City Engineer James Geurtz who
 performed a site inspection. He signed off on the plat and stated that the issue should resolve itself over time as
 vegetation regrows in the area. The culvert needs to be cleaned out but the contractor and Benton County will
 need to connect to resolve this issue as it is not inside the City limits.
- Recorder/Treasurer Richard Crow recognized Finance Specialist Donna Gann who is doing a tremendous job.
 She continues to provide valued contributions to the City and is a committed team player. Mayor Van Sickler agreed, and Wes Usrey noted that she is extremely good at her job. Council members who know her agreed and were happy to support her as needed.
