The City Council of Little Flock, Arkansas met in regular session on Monday, June 15, 2026 at 6:00 PM in the Sunshine School.

1. Meeting called to Order:

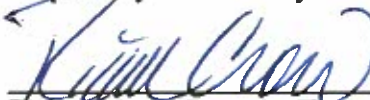

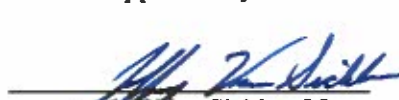
